NCI HAMFEST:

He placed a note indicating where equipment is located. "C" is for the cabinet he repaired. (L) is for the storage unit to the left of the cabinet and (RR) is for the radio room. John, KB9SIR, asked about back up keys for the equipment storage locations. Marion will see about getting spare keys made. He will see about posting a note on the cabinet indicating who has keys.
